Existing Bylaw –14.10.1 An Appeal matter may come within the jurisdiction of the Appeals Committee in the following ways:

a) Appeal from the decision or ruling of a Member:

In the event that a Member, Member of a Member, Official or other persons is dissatisfied with a decision or ruling made by a Member and provided that:

- i. The decision or ruling relates to the subject matter of the Bylaws, Policies or Rules and Regulations; and
- ii. All Appeal avenues as provided by the Member have been exhausted; the said Member, Member of Member, Official or other person may appeal the aforesaid decision or ruling to the Appeals Committee.

b) Appeal from a decision of the Commissioners or Vice President pursuant to Bylaw 9.02.3 f) and 9.05.3 g), h), i) and k);

Proposed Bylaw:

Change to:

14.10.1 An Appeal may come within the jurisdiction of the Appeals Committee in the following ways:

a) Appeal from the decision or ruling of a Member in the event that a Member, Member of a Member, Official or other persons is dissatisfied with a decision or ruling made by a Member and provided that:

- i. The decision or ruling relates to the subject matter of the Bylaws, Policies or Rules and Regulations; and***
- ii. All Appeal avenues as provided by the Member have been exhausted;***
